## Harry Greenstein Young Leadership Winners Announced

The Associated: Jewish Community Federation of Baltimore recently announced that Rachel Steinberg Warschawski and Will Minkin were named the 2014 winners of **The Harry Greenstein Young Leadership Award**. The Harry Greenstein Young Leadership Award salutes a young man and woman who have demonstrated sustained leadership for The Associated, its Annual Campaign and the general community.

The awards were presented at an Associated board meeting.

Warschawski was recognized for her ability to delegate and motivate a team, as evidenced by the highly successful ECOFAIR. She organized her committee, coordinated a vendor expo and arranged for entertainment, pulling off a well-orchestrated event for the community. A thoughtful leader, she is a strong advocate for the Pearlstone Center, where she evaluates programs and creative approaches to new ideas. The Pearlstone Center is an agency of The Associated.

Minkin, who was honored for his commitment and sense of deep responsibility to The Associated, has held leadership positions with the organization since 2008. He has served on several committees through The Associated's Center for Community Engagement and Leadership (CCEL), including the CCEL Agency Board Development Committee and most recently, was chair of the board for the Jewish Community Center.

Warschawski and Minkin received trips to the Jewish Federation of North America's (JFNA) General Assembly, the premier leadership retreat for federation professionals and volunteers.
