

GRANT GUIDELINES

- Funding will support new, inspiring and innovative programs in the Baltimore area that will engage the new Jewish family with children up to 18 years old.
- Organizations may seek support for an existing program if they are meaningfully changing their program model to be more relevant to the new Jewish family.
- Pilot programs that have been in existence for up to two (2) years are eligible to apply for funding.
- Grants awarded will be between \$10,000 and \$50,000.
- Multi-year grants may be considered.
- Projects will be funded for no more than three (3) consecutive years.
- Collaborative programs among organizations are encouraged.
- Funds may not be used for loans, scholarships, political campaigns or capital projects.
- Grants will not be made to individuals.

ELIGIBILITY

Any school (Jewish, public or private), Associated agency or program, local Jewish organization, or congregation. National organizations need to identify a local partner.

Grants will be awarded to 501(c)(3) organizations or those sponsored by a fiscal agent with their own 501(c)(3) status

Organizations must have an active volunteer board or functioning lay leadership structure.
